*Per capita: The Grand Lodge shall annually, by resolution, assess upon each Member of the Order annual dues, in such amount and to be paid in such manner as may be prescribed by the Grand Lodge, for raising revenue to meet the expenses of the Grand Lodge, including the maintenance of the National Headquarters and for the expense of publishing and distributing The Elks Magazine.

Notice of Increase in Cocktail Prices

In order to keep up with rising liquor prices and the increase in the cost of doing business, our charge for cocktails will be going up \$1 across the board. Well drinks will be \$5, and call drinks \$6. Premium will be increased accordingly. We're still the best game in town, and at this point beer and wine prices are not affected.
